

PARENT / GUARDIAN RESPECT CODE OF CONDUCT

The Crofts Estate Agents Youth Football League is supporting the FA's Respect programme to ensure that football can be enjoyed in a safe and positive environment. Play your part and observe the FA's Respect Code of Conduct for spectators and parents/carers at all times.

- Remember that children play for FUN
- Applaud effort and good play as well as success
- Always respect the match officials' decisions
- Remain outside the field of play and in/behind the Designated Spectator's Area/Barriers
- Let the coach do their job and not confuse the players by telling them what to do
- Encourage the players to respect the opposition, referee and match officials
- Avoid criticising a player for making a mistake mistakes are part of learning
- Never engage in, or tolerate, offensive, insulting, or abusive language or behaviour.
- Be aware that from time to time you may be chosen by the coach to act as the match day RESPECT officer and ensure spectators remain in/behind designated areas
- Be prepared to move behind the designated spectator barrier when requested to do so by another parent, match official, club official, league official or match day respect officer.

The use of RESPECT barriers plays a critical part in player development. Each pitch will be setup so coaches/players are on one side and spectators/parents are on the other.

I understand that if I do not follow the Code, any/all of the following actions may be taken by my club, County FA, league or the FA:

- I may be Issued with a verbal warning from a club or league official
- I may be Required to meet with the club, league or County FA Welfare Officer
- I may be Required to meet with the club committee
- I may be Obligated to leave the match venue by the club
- I may be Requested by the club not to attend future games
- I may be Suspended or have my club membership removed
- I may be Required to leave the club along with any dependents.
- The FA/County FA/League could impose a fine and/or suspension on the club.

I understand the following FA/League rules are in place in this league:

- I am aware of the transfer policy in this league
- I am aware that no smoking (including e-cigarettes and vaporisers) or drinking of alcohol is allowed at the side of pitches
- I am aware that each player is entitled to play at least 50% of any match they are chosen for. If your son/daughter does not receive 50% you are entitled to challenge the coach and report to the Crofts Estate Agents Youth Football League.
- I understand that I am not allowed to publish results of development fixtures (including on social media)
