INFORMATION FOR VISITING TEAMS AND MATCH OFFICIALS

Parking / Access to Venue

Car parking should be in the car parking areas provided, entering through the double gates.

Toilet / Facilities

Items to include are where are the toilets located and how do you access them, how many people are allowed in the buildings at any one time, any one-way system in place, what cleaning processes are in place

The toilets are in the club house and are clearly signposted. They will have been thoroughly cleaned prior to use and will be cleaned after every fixture. Visitors are advised to wipe the toilet seats before use place the toilet lid down prior to flushing. Seats should be wiped using anti-bac wipes after flushing. All used wipes should be placed in the lidded bins provided

Information for Parents/Spectators

Items to include are where should spectators stand before, during and after the match has taken place, any out of bounds areas, any other processes they need to follow on site

spectators should stand behind the respect lines on the pitch being used. They should stand in groups of no more than 6 and should be 2 metres distant from other groups where possible. In the absence of a one way system, spectators will be asked to keep to socially distancing measures when arriving at the site and walking to the pitches.

At the end of the fixtures parents should wait for the players keeping a socially distance space between other waiting parents.

The club will ask for contact details of all visitors - a name and a phone number which will be kept for

Information for Coaches

Items to include are where should coaches setup for pre-match warm ups, when can teams use goals for pre-match warm ups, what procedures are in place for keeping equipment clean, where should coaches stand during matches

Coaches on arrival should liaise with the home side coaches / or the COVID officers and they will advice them to set up areas and where to participate in pre match warm ups and where to stand during matches

Wipes and sanitisers will be available for visiting coaches to use if necessary.

General Information for all participants

Items to include are what processes does this venue have for track and trace, who should they contact with any queries before match day, how is risk being mitigated at this venue

Contact details will be requested from the coaches on arrival.

Spectators will be asked to provide names and contact numbers on arrival and these will be kept in the clubs records for a minimum of 21 days.

Any queries prior to any matches can be made to the COVID officers (contact details listed above) If there are any issues relating to COVID that need to be provided to the visiting teams, contact will be made to the visiting Team's secretary as soon as is reasonably possible.
