INFORMATION FOR VISITING TEAMS AND MATCH OFFICIALS

Parking / Access to Venue

Items to include are where should visiting teams park, which entrance should they use, are there any one-way systems in place, when can they arrive, how quickly do they need to leave afterwards?

The carpark is currently not available to use. You can however drive through the car park and turn left and park behind the score box. Alternatively please park outside the ground and walk down.

Toilet / Facilities

Items to include are where are the toilets located and how do you access them, how many people are allowed in the buildings at any one time, any one-way system in place, what cleaning processes are in place

Should the clubhouse be open during matches the following rules must be undertaken. Face masks worn and hands sanitised before entry to the toilets which are clearly marked. A strict one person at a time policy to enter the toilets. Again if the clubhouse is open a text facility will be in force to order drinks. No one is permitted to enter the clubhouse to order drinks.

If the clubhouse is not open then after games have finished spectators and parents are asked to vacate the premises in an orderly fashion whilst maintaining social distancing rules in accordance with the government.

Information for Parents/Spectators

Items to include are where should spectators stand before, during and after the match has taken place, any out of bounds areas, any other processes they need to follow on site

Upon arrival details of all players and spectators will be taken and recorded on our spreadsheets for track and trace purposes. All players and spectators must turn left in the car park and go directly towards the pitch towards the scorebox. All players, spectators and officials will be asked to sanitise upon arrival whilst taking down personal details. The spectators will be asked to not congregate in

large groups other than their own household bubbles. Everyone will be asked to social distance in accordance with the government guidelines. The home and away supporters will also be allocated their own areas away from each other at pitchside.

Information for Coaches

Items to include are where should coaches setup for pre-match warm ups, when can teams use goals for pre-match warm ups, what procedures are in place for keeping equipment clean, where should coaches stand during matches

Only coaches are to come into contact with training equipment, goals, cones etc. Any minor injuries or issues are to be seen by managers/coaches only whicle a game is being played. Any major issues involving the children where the parent/guardian is needed will be dealt with accordingly. Social distancing rules also apply to all coaches/managers

General Information for all participants

Items to include are what processes does this venue have for track and trace, who should they contact with any queries before match day, how is risk being mitigated at this venue

Once the game has finished please be aware of other parents/spectators around you and leave the pitch side accordingly, sticking to your own groups whilst observing social distances where possible. Players will return to their coaches/managers after the final whistle where they will ensure they are led back to their parents/guardians safely.

Anyone visting the facility should be reminded of social distancing and respecting of not only others at the facility but also the staff working who may be conducting additional cleaning/checks.
