Parking / Access to Venue

Access to the school for both vehicles and pedestrians will be through the main gate on Weelsby Avenue. Parking at the school will be as normal and drivers are reminded to follow the road round to the left on entry to the car parks bordering the field. The parking at the school reception is for disabled badge holders only & we recommend that everyone parks in relation to where their pitch is located. We are not expecting any games to be played directly before or after league games but this aside please do not arrive more than 30mins prior to your kick off time and please vacate the premises directly after your game finishes. Finally, please avoid any congregating in the car park.

Toilet / Facilities

Where necessary the toilets can be accessed through the main reception. To reduce the usage of toilets for hand washing only, we are recommending as stated in the F.A. guidance that teams bring their own hand washing/sanitising equipment to use pitch side. The facility staff will monitor the access, use and cleaning of the facilities throughout the day

Information for Parents/Spectators

Prior to the game, designated spectator areas will be marked using the respect line along the side of each pitch in use. Spectators should maintain social distancing around the venue whilst making sure they avoiding standing in large groups. As the game ends we would ask spectators to vacate the facility in a safe manner and avoid congregating in the car park.

Information for Coaches

All coaches should follow the FA guidelines on protocol. On the coaches side of each pitch there is adequate space to perform any warm up/cool down activities away from other users. As is protocol scheduled hygiene breaks during the game where necessary and our team being the home team will clean equipment and encourage good hand hygiene during this period.

General Information for all participants

All users should read the FA's self assessment prior to travelling to the venue and should not travel if they have shown any of the symptoms listed. Users will be encouraged to maintain social distancing where possible and good hand hygiene will be encouraged during the hygiene breaks. Track and trace will be the responsibility of the clubs as users and in the event of a request will make their registers available.
