INFORMATION FOR VISITING TEAMS AND MATCH OFFICIALS

Parking / Access to Venue

Items to include are where should visiting teams park, which entrance should they use, are there any one-way systems in place, when can they arrive, how quickly do they need to leave afterwards?

when arriving on site you will be instructed were to park. Once full you will be able to park on the road. The use of ST Hughes hospital car park is banned at the moment. You should arrive at the ground 15 minutes before the designated KO times and vacate the premises as quickly as possible once your match as finished. Coaches/managers to arrive 30mins before KO times in order to take the goals to their designated pitch.

Toilet / Facilities

Items to include are where are the toilets located and how do you access them, how many people are allowed in the buildings at any one time, any one-way system in place, what cleaning processes are in place

ladies/gents and disabled toilets are located just inside the main entrance. Only one person in at time unless children who should be supervised by an adult. Hands must be sanitized on entering and leaving and toilet left clean. Paper towels are in the dispenser and when used disposed of in the bin provided. The changing rooms are not in use unless for an emergency. If they are required strict hygiene should be maintained. Toilets and changing rooms, if used, should be left in a clean and safe. The kitchen must not be used by anyone other than the trustees.

Information for Parents/Spectators

Items to include are where should spectators stand before, during and after the match has taken place, any out of bounds areas, any other processes they need to follow on site

All parents and spectators should make their way to the allocated pitch and stand behind the respect barrier maintaining social distancing. They must not congregate on the car park before or

Information for Coaches

Items to include are where should coaches setup for pre-match warm ups, when can teams use goals for pre-match warm ups, what procedures are in place for keeping equipment clean, where should coaches stand during matches

Coaches my use half the pitch to warm up, weather permitting, or the area immediately adjacent to the pitch. Teams should refrain from using the goals before the KO. It is the home teams responsibility to ensure the goals are put in place and erected correctly prior to ko. Sanitised at regular intervals and stored on completion of the match. Coaches to stand on the opposite side to the respect barrier ensuring social distances are maintained. Players must not be allowed to wonder round the ground and if toilets are required they must be taken by an adult to ensure hygiene is maintained.

General Information for all participants

Items to include are what processes does this venue have for track and trace, who should they contact with any queries before match day, how is risk being mitigated at this venue

When on site each Club is responsible keep a register of their players and spectators. People on site from the Leagues details to entered into the on site diary
